

# APPLICATION FOR AN INDEPENDENT PROGRAM OF STUDY

A Traditional Studies student wishing to declare a program of study not officially offered by Tusculum University may declare an Independent Program of Study. Applicants must have at least a 2.75 GPA and have a second semester sophomore standing. Students must solicit approval from their advisor, the College Dean of the primary area of study, and the Admissions & Standards Committee.

## Independent Program of Study with two areas:

A minimum of 30 hours in the primary area.\*  
A minimum of 21 hours in the secondary area.  
Total of 51 hours – a minimum of 18 hours of coursework at the 300 or 400 level required.

\*Primary area must be an existing major.

## Independent Program of Study with three areas:

A minimum of 24 hours in the primary area.\*  
A minimum of 18 hours in the secondary area.  
A minimum of 12 hours in the tertiary area.  
Total of 54 hours – a minimum of 18 hours of coursework at the 300 or 400 level required.

\*Primary area must be an existing major.
